## **Twin Harbors Community Beach Rules**

- ❖ All vehicles parked by beachgoers must display a Twin Harbors Sticker, a Twin Harbors hang tag, or a printed and dated Guest pass with the Twin Harbors logo, or risk the vehicle being towed. Beachgoers from unidentified vehicles may also be asked to leave our private property.
- ❖ Please be mindful when setting up your chairs, blankets, etc. and don't block easy access to the beach for others entering from the walkway with their supplies.
- If your entire group is leaving the beach after setting up, and wishes to leave the equipment for their return, please fold up chairs, blankets, etc. so others may use the space during the absence. Please don't 'stake-out' space and leave.
- ❖ There is no trash receptacle at the beach. Please take away anything you brought in with you − remember 'Carry In and Carry Out'. (Please consider removing additional washed up trash and plastic as well!)
- No motorized vehicles except golf carts are permitted past the fence line to the Community Beach and picnic area. Carts must stay where there is gravel. Motorized personal mobility devices may access any area they can traverse.
- No motorized watercraft may be pulled up onshore. They may be anchored past the groins, to avoid damage to the groins and contact with other beachgoers.
- The bench must stay at the far end of the platform for accessibility. Please do not move it.
- Pets are allowed on the beach. Owners are expected to:
  - ❖ Keep them under immediate control and on a leash when other beachgoers or other pets are present.
  - Clean up all solid pet waste and carry it out.
- ❖ No open fires (cooking or bonfire) are permitted on the Beach. Portable grills and hibachis may be used all briquettes/coals/fuel must be 'carried out' when the user leaves the beach. No coals or embers may be buried or left on or near the beach or picnic area!
- No overnight stays or camping (with or without a shelter) are permitted on the beach.
- ❖ Please fill in all holes dug by people or pets before you leave to prevent injuries at high tide when the 'pit' may no longer be fully visible!
- Please respect the boundaries of the private property beaches at either end of the Community Beach.
- ❖ The Porta-Potty is a community amenity; please keep it neat and clean!
  - Do not dispose of anything other than toilet paper and human body waste in the Porta-Potty.
  - No: doggy poop bags; empty drink bottles; sanitary products; food waste, etc.
  - ❖ Do Not Move the Porta-Potty!
